transculturation keywords for american cultural studies

May 25th, 2020 - the term originally coined by cuban sociologist fernando ortiz in the 1940s aimed to replace overly reductive concepts of acculturation and assimilation used to characterize culture under conquest while subordinate peoples do not usually control what emanates from the dominant culture they do determine to varying extents what get absorbed into their own and what it gets used for 'philology' britannica
